Alternatively, you may wish to designate your donation for a specific hunger relief, quality of life program or project approved by the CCWN Volunteer Board of Directors. Examples of the impact your contribution makes:

- \$25 Formula and diapers for a baby for a week
- \$50 Hot water for a family of 4 for a month
- \$75 Backpack filled with supplies for a student
- \$100 Personal Emergency support to an individual or family in crisis
- \$250 Food and supply hamper for a family of 4
- \$500 Deposit to secure housing for a family
- \$1000 Six months of perishables for a family
- \$2500 One year of grain products for a family
- \$5000 One new gift yearly for each CCWN child

Did you know?

A charitable donation is one of the best ways for you to reduce personal income tax.

A charitable tax receipt will be issued for donations over \$20.

A donation of \$1,000 to CCWN would reduce your tax or increase your refund by approximately \$361.

The refund generated on the first \$200 of donations would be at 20% however once your total donations to all charities exceeds \$200 then the refund percentage becomes 40%.

The Donation Credit is a non-refundable tax credit which means that you have to be paying tax in a year for the refund to be generated.
